#### Description

Lorraine is available for telehealth appointments ONLY.

Lorraine is licensed as a Marriage & Family Therapist in several states and certified as an ICGC-II which is specialized training in working with those impacted by compulsive gambling. Lorraine also holds a BACC which permits her supervision of other therapists who are looking to obtain this credential.

Despite the license name of Marriage & Family Therapist, a licensee is trained and qualified to deliver psychotherapeutic services to individuals as well as couples, & families. Therapeutic issues addressed involve: couple conflict, trauma, domestic violence, co-dependency, parenting support, grief, adoption, blended families, attachment, addiction (gambling specialty), recovery support, and adolescence stressors/peer relationships. Lorraine has also been trained in EMDR therapy which is well known for its effective use with trauma and anxiety.

Lorraine Barry obtained her Ed.S. from Seton Hall University in 1993. In 1988 Lorraine obtained her Master's Degree in Developmental Psychology from Columbia University. In 1986 Lorraine obtained her Bachelor's Degree from the CUNY system of NYC.

Lorraine has been a past president of the Central Chapter of NJ-AAMFT and past member of the NJ-AAMFT Ethics Committee. Lorraine formerly served on the Educational Committee for the National Council on Compulsive gambling. Lorraine also served as a member of the NJ State Licensing Board for seven years and was chair of the Licensing Board for 3 years. Lorraine Barry is a Clinical Member of The American Association for Marriage & Family Therapy (AAMFT) and is an AAMFT Approved Supervisor. AAMFT is the professional association for the field of Marriage & Family Therapy.

Sliding Scale Fee Policy: The full session fee can be adjusted to a minimum fee of \$70.00. A client's ability to receive a sliding scale is reviewed annually. Proof of residency is needed to show current address along with proof of income for wages earned over 4 consecutive weeks. A declaration of income received from all other possible sources is requested.

Diagnostic Intake Fee: \$145.00 (Sliding Scale rate - \$95.00)

Individual Psychotherapy Session Fee: \$120.00 (Sliding Scale rate - \$70.00)

Family/Couples Counseling Session Fee: \$120.00 (Sliding Scale rate - \$70.00)

Telehealth Session (via Zoom or Facetime) Fee: \$120.00 (Sliding Scale rate - \$70.00)

\*ONLY takes telehealth appointments; there are no in-person appointments.\*
