Description

The Plantation Tuesday Night Gam-Anon Meeting takes place at the St. Benedict's Episcopal Church on Tuesday nights from 7:00pm-9:30pm (ET).

CLOSED GA MEETING & SEPARATE GAM-ANON MEETING ON SITE - This location offers a Gambler's Anonymous Meeting and a separate Gam-Anon meeting; both meetings are held in different rooms but at the same time.

Description of Location: St. Benedict's Episcopal Church is located east of University Drive. The GA meeting is held in the Elizabeth Room, and the Gam-Anon meeting is held in the Peters Room. Park in the back of the parking lot, which is where these rooms are located.

GAM-ANON

-Gam-Anon is for persons adversely affected by the gambler, such as family members and friends. Members are provided opportunities for learning how to cope with the gambler and accompanying difficulties. It is similar in structure and function to GA. It is not necessary for the gambler to attend Gamblers Anonymous in order for a family member, friend or other loved one to participate in the Gam-Anon program. Members are provided opportunities for learning how to cope with the gambler and accompanying difficulties. It is similar in structure and function to GA.

-Gam-Anon has devised 20 Questions that individuals can answer for purposes of determining Are You Living with a Compulsive Gambler?

-Additional points you should know about GA and Gam-Anon include:

-Both GA and Gam-Anon (and other similar self-help groups) function based upon 12 guiding principles and 12 steps; hence the name 12-step programs. These self-help fellowships do not have leaders and members agreeing to chair a meeting or perform other functions do so as a service, which is voluntary. Furthermore, GA and Gam-Anon do not align themselves with outside organizations. As such, they do not become involved with political or other matters and do not accept financial contributions from outside entities.

-At times, callers and others will confuse the FCCG with GA by thinking the two organizations are synonymous. This is incorrect. GA is a self-help group of men and women who meet regularly to share their experience, strength and hope in abstaining from gambling. The FCCG is a not-for-profit independent corporation that provides prevention, education, resource referral and training programs. This is also true nationwide as all GA and Gam-Anon fellowships operate in the same manner regardless of location.
